

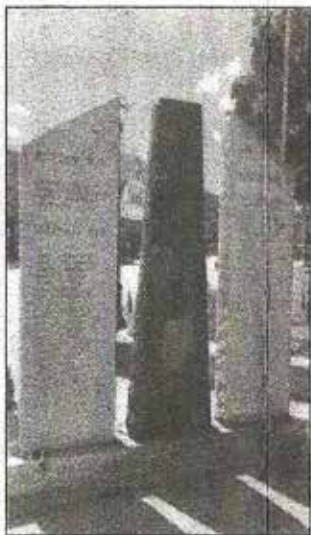
Danville Optimists sponsor war memorial cleaning

The Danville Optimist Club sponsors the cleaning of the War Memorial Monument on the northeast corner of the Hendricks County Court House Square in Danville.

The War Memorial recognizes servicemen from Hendricks County who perished in World War I, World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. The memorial was established in 1992 by the Danville Jaycees and Pittsboro Jaycees.

The cleaning was performed March 26 by Stonehugger Cemetery Restoration Company from Brown County, which is owned and operated by Helen Wildermuth. The cleaning was performed as a donation by Wildermuth who stated it was her opportunity to give back to the community.

Her company has restored cemeteries in Indiana, Illinois, Iowa, Ohio and Michigan.
